This year has seen a hive of activity through events, workshops, single use waste reduction, new website building and a whole heap of collaboration.

Green Drinks is our monthly event series. Running for over 5 years, we host speakers, workshops, outdoor excursions, films and social get-togethers that bring people, ideas and knowledge together over a drink each month!

Imagine an event without disposable food cartons and cups filling the bins. Say hello to DISHrupt - disrupting our dependency on disposables. Since 2018, DISHrupt has kept over 90,000 disposables out of landfill by providing reusable dishes!

ResOURceful Communities is our collaborative programme with Wastebusters - bringing the Repair Revolution, Slow Fashion Month, Low Waste Living Workshops and Plastic Free July activities to Queenstown. This annual programme of events celebrates slowing down, reusing and working together.

From a Bob's Cove walk and learning with Southern Lakes Sanctuary, to our KiwiHarvest rescue dinner at Millbrook, a gear swap at Patagonia that rehomed 150 items, and talking all things sustainable food with Michael Sly & Nadia Lim at Skyline, our FY24 Green Drinks programme of 10 events was varied and valuable.







FY25 - WHAT'S TO COME?

2025 is all about amplification!

Our team will be growing with the recruitment of more trustees to join the board, and two new contractors to a) project manage DISHrupt, Green Drinks and SUCfree, and b) manage the DISHrupt and SUCfree operations.

These new contractor roles will allow us to grow our operations and impact in reducing single-use items in Queenstown Lakes, while better understanding how to make our initiatives more financially self-sufficient.

We will be engaging with more businesses in our district to reduce the dependence on disposables and increase awareness of DISHrupt and SUCfree as more sustainable options.

Onboarding new trustees brings fresh perspective and experience to support the strategic direction of Sustainable Queenstown. Having more people around the board table will allow us to further three more projects; a) awareness and b) funding - solidifying a sponsorship and grants approach to take us through the year and beyond, and c) a more regular volunteer programme - bringing more enthusiastic locals into the fold to support and widen our initiatives.
